




- Nonviolent drug possession cases are too few and unimpactful to affect public health or safety, especially with recent criminal justice reforms
- Crime specialization is a myth
- Most violent offenders do not recidivate more often or differently than drug or property offenders
- Drug courts are more effective for felony cases
- Drug courts are as, or more, effective for drug dealing and violence cases
- Removing unwarranted eligibility restrictions reduces racial and ethnic disparities
- Subjective suitability determinations exacerbate disparities and lessen outcomes


#### **% Drug Courts Excluding These Candidates**






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


Re-Arrest Rate: 2005 - 2014 (9-year follow-up)





Re-Arrest Rate: 2005 - 2014 (9-year follow-up)








Re-Arrest Rate: 2005 - 2010 (5-year follow-up)




#### 24 Domestic Violence Courts Across NY State




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
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



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



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








- ➤ Eligibility & exclusion criteria are based on empirical evidence of safety and effectiveness
- > Assessment process is evidence-based
  - Objective eligibility criteria
  - High risk & high need participants
  - Validated assessment tools
  - Criminal history disqualifications
  - Clinical disqualifications
